### METHOD OF APPOINTMENT

2. The posts shall be filled in as follows:—

Provided that if no suitable person is available for promotion, the post or posts reserved for promotion shall be filled by initial appointment and failing that by transfer.

#### QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

4. A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age limits mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule to this notification provided that:—

- (i) the maximum age limits will be relaxed by three years in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Buddhist Community, the recognized tribes of the Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir and the Northern Areas, in accordance with the instructions issued by the Government;
- (ii) for Government servants who have completed at least two years' continuous Government service, the maximum age limit will be relaxed by not more than 10 years upto the age of 55 years, wherever applicable; and
- (iii) the maximum age limit in case of released/retired commissioned officers of the Armed Forces of Pakistan will be relaxed upto a maximum of 10 years or by the number of years an officers has actually served the Armed Forces, whichever is less.

#### APPOINTMENT BY TRANSFER

5. Appointment by transfer shall be made from amongst the persons holding appointment on regular basis under the Federal Government in the same Basic Pay Scale in which the post to be filled exist, provided that the person concerned possesses the qualifications and experience prescribed for initial appointment or promotion to the post concerned.

PROBATION

6. Persons appointed by promotion, initial appointment or transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded, or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of section-6 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973.

7. This notification issues with the concurrence of the Establishment Division vide their O. M. No. 5/5/89-R. 3 dated 17-3-1990 and the Federal Public Service Commission vide their letter No. F. 12-17/90-S, dated 17th September, 1991, respectively.


