S. R. O. 854 (I)|86.—The following draft of an amendment in the Income Tax Rules, 1982, which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 165 of the Income Tax Ordinance, 1979 (XXXI of 1979), is hereby published as required by sub-section (4) of section 165 for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and it is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration after seven days of its publication in the official Gazette.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person in respect of the said draft before the expiry of the said period will be considered by the Central Board of Revenue.

In the aforesaid Rules, in rule 48, in sub-rule (2), in clause (b), after the words "may be", the commas, words, letters, figures and brackets ", and, in the case of plant and machinery to which Notification No. S. R. O. 200 (I)|81, dated the 14th March, 1981, applies, includes the Assistant Collector of Customs and Central Excise concerned" shall be inserted.

S. R. O. 855 (I)|86.—In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of rule 3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973, the following method, qualifications and other conditions are laid down for appointment to the undermentioned posts in the Computer Cell, Pakistan Railways:—

- (i) Data Processing Manager (Computerization) (BPS-19);
- (ii) System Analyst (BPS-18);
- (iii) Sr. Programmer (BPS-18); and
- (iv) Programmer (BPS-17).

METHOD OF APPOINTMENT

2. (a) The posts of Data Processing Manager (Computerization), System Analyst Sr. Programmer shall be filled by promotion in accordance with rule 3 below.

(b) 20 per cent of the posts of Programmer shall be filled by promotion in accordance with rule 3 of these rules and the remaining 80 per cent posts shall be filled by initial appointment in accordance with rule 4 below.

(c) Provided that if no one is found suitable for promotion to the post or posts reserved for promotion such post or posts shall be filled by initial appointment and failing that by transfer.

CONDITIONS FOR PROMOTION

3. Promotions to posts in column 1 below shall be made by selection from amongst the persons who hold the posts specified in column 2 on a regular basis and possess the qualifications and experience prescribed in column 3:

Promotion of BPS-14 and BPS-10 officials to be made when no suitable BPS-16 officer is available. (ii) Three months course in Computer Programming in COBOL, FORTRAN or High level language essential.

QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

4. A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age limits as mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule to this Notification:

Provided that the maximum age limits will be relaxed by 3 years in the case of candidates belonging to Schedule Castes, Buddhist Community recognized tribes of the Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir and Northern Areas, (District of Gilgit, Skardu and Diamir), in accordance with the instructions issued by the Establishment Division:

Provided further that for Government servants who have completed at least 2 years continuous Government service, maximum age limit may be relaxed by not more than 10 years upto the age of 55 years.

QUALIFICATIONS|CONDITIONS FOR TRANSFER

5. Appointments by transfer shall be made from amongst the persons holding appointment under the Federal Government on a regular basis in the same Basic Pay Scale in which the post to be filled exists, provided the person concerned possess the qualifications|experience prescribed for initial appointment or promotion to the post concerned.

PROBATION

6. Persons appointed by promotion or initial appointment or transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded, or, if considered necessary it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of section 6 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973.

7. This Notification issues with the concurrence of the Establishment Division as contained in their O.M. No. 33|2|81-R. 5 dated the 23rd July, 1985 and the Federal Public Service Commission as contained in their letter No. F. 12-61|81 S. dated the 9th April, 1985 and 14th July, 1985.
