

NOTIFICATION

No. Admn-IV/2032-P-Compensation. Consequent upon the judgment of Federal Service Tribunal (FST), Islamabad, dated 11.04.2025 passed in Appeal No. 59(R)CS/2021 filed by Mr. Muhammad Ali Rajpar, a BS-18 officer of Mechanical Engineering Department of Pakistan Railways presently working as MET (BS-18), Pakistan Railways, Moghalpura, Lahore, and on the recommendations of the Department Committee constituted in terms of ESTACODE Rule Sl. No. 32.10(2), the competent authority (Secretary Railways) has been pleased to approve the intervening period from 12.09.2014 to 21.03.2016 and from 10.09.2020 to 29.04.2025 treated as **duty** in the light of FR-54(a) in favor of Mr. Muhammad Ali Rajpar, subject to the final outcome of the CPLA.

2. The said period was decided subject to the condition that the officer will deposit/ return all the financial and other benefits which were given to him, if the decision of CPLA filed against the above mentioned FST decision, does not come in his favour.
