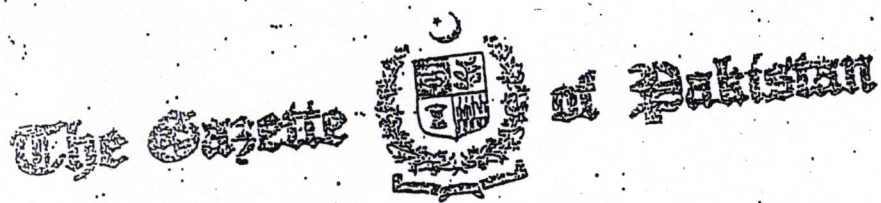

QUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

4. A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age limits as mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule to this Notification, provided that :—

- (i) 'Experience' means, the experience gained in a regular full time paid job after attaining the prescribed basic qualifications.
